A secondhand milking plant had been sold to a customer with the intention of shipping it to Cambodia,

where it was meant to be set up and used. However, the plan didn't work out, and the equipment was sold to another party. In late 2017, Steve received an email from an American named Bill. who was setting up a farm in Cambodia called MooMoo Farms. Bill explained that he had a container of milking machine parts but was unsure how to put it all together.

After many email exchanges, Steve decided to take matters into his own hands and flew to Cambodia to see what he could do to help. Upon arrival, Steve was transported by tuk-tuk to his accommodation, already feeling a bit out of his comfort zone. The next day, he met with Bill and made his way to the farmfirst by tuk-tuk, then by barge across the Mekong River. On-site, Steve quickly assessed what additional parts were needed to complete the installation. The farm workers were eager to assist, and Steve was impressed by their enthusiasm and hospitality.

Two days later, Steve returned home, and

the necessary parts were ordered A team of two fitters, Jason and Will, along with over 100 kg of extra luggage, set off for Cambodia. The job took eight days to complete, with the help of a translator and the farm workers. It was a historic moment when
